Petition: Liberty from Lockdown

We, the people of Camas, Washington, urge the Camas City Council to make an informed, non-partisan vote to approve a resolution declaring Camas a "sanctuary city" not subject to Governor Jay Inslee's stay-at-home orders and phased reopening amid COVID-19. We urge the mayor then to adopt this resolution as science and data have continued to show that this virus is no worse than any virus, and that health is the personal responsibility of each individual to maintain.

The resolution would put Camas Police on notice that the executive orders from Olympia are not law, and are not enforceable. As governor, Inslee does not write law, his "orders" are guidelines, guidelines without reason.

The resolution would also eliminate any obligation on the part of the city to regulate or fine businesses that defy the state order. Business owners should be supported and protected from these unconstitutional non-laws that have devastated our community and our small businesses. Clark County has already taken the stance for months that they will not enforce any of Inslee's orders.

Most of the people of Camas initially supported the governor's 'Stay at Home' order. We were faced with an unknown threat and the measures taken ranged from prudent to drastic. With the data we now have, continuing with the phased approach of reopening is unacceptable.

The people of Washington are not being governed, we are being ruled by executive orders. These are not laws. Camas is better and stronger than that and we have an opportunity to follow the lead of strong Sheriffs across Washington, and cities and counties that have pushed back against Inslee's orders that have done so much damage.

Those of us that wish to return to normal, accepting personal responsibility for our own health (as we always have done), should be able to do so. And for those that wish to wear masks, and social distance, let them do so. Let us keep Camas as a fine city for ALL to coexist.

HOWEVER...

As this issue has become so heavily politicized with intense scrutiny and repercussions on all sides, it is unlikely that Camas Leadership will take such a strong stance. To that end, we request that the Council approve a resolution to acknowledge this series of facts:

1. As more data points are gathered, the conclusions and prescriptions developed from these data must evolve to reflect what we've learned.
2. Knowledge is not static, especially with something like a "novel" virus. Original models of death were egregiously wrong, new data shows death rate of 0.12% from USC and Stanford, that means 99.8%+ of people survive a COVID-19 infection. And the death rate among healthy people under 50 is even lower.

3. Treatment for COVID-19 was incorrect. It has been proven that intubation (ventilators) is effectively a death sentence for those hospitalized with the virus. Oxygen treatment is far more effective. This improper handling,

and strict adherence to the wrong medical protocol has artificially inflated the number of deaths (particularly in New York and New Jersey).

4. It has been documented that deaths have been routinely miscategorized as being FROM the virus, when the decedent only died WITH the virus; which has further increased the number of false deaths.

5. Despite that, survival rate is 99.8%+, and further data has developed showing an even lesser rate of death.

6. As COVID infection manifests mild or no symptoms for most, most people won't get tested. If they were, this would push down the death rate significantly. In Clark County we have been unable to get tested until late May unless you had both symptoms AND were in a high risk group. As of mid-July, you must still have symptoms even to get a test, so we are 3+ months in with testing focused on those in the worst health. Again, this skews the reported fatality rate.

7. Inslee requires advancement to further Phases based on a limitation of 25 cases per 100,000 people in each county. At the same time, he wants to increase testing to 20k/day, when we are only at 11k per weekday as of early July, and prior to early June we were only at 6k/weekday. This was an increase of testing by 87%, and yet positive tests only increased by 49%. Again, this proves nothing, as they are literally hunting for more cases. Which they will find, because the virus is so easily transmitted, and so mild. 
*Data:

-From 5/18 to 6/7 (3 weeks) there were 101,238 tests, 5552 were positive for 5.48% positive.
4820 avg tests per day

-6/8 marked a sharp increase in testing

-From 6/8 to 6/28 (3 weeks) there were 189,641 tests, 8296 were positive for 4.37% positive.
9031 avg tests per day

-Overall positive results dropped by 20%



8. Testing is full of false positives, whether antigen or antibody, and even PCR has its problems. All of the testing is limited in its effectiveness based on timing of when the test is taken compared to the subject's illness or lack thereof. And all positive results are limited in their ability to document that the subject is a transmission risk, as they can show positive even when the subject is well past an infectious stage . Meaning Inslee's case limitations to advance to further Phases has no functional purpose.

9. Inslee's orders to determine who and what is or is not essential has no basis in science to actually prevent the spread of a virus. Shutting down small businesses, while allowing large businesses like Costco, Walmart, etc. to remain open only pushed more people into the same space at larger stores. It is impossible to disinfect every product and every surface, to pretend otherwise is foolish. Smaller businesses have less traffic. Air moves. Having plastic partitions does little to prevent microscopic particles from traveling to mucous membranes, face masks only limit the distance of initial travel, but once airborne, the particles can travel just the same. Requiring masks at the entrance to a restaurant, but allowing them to be removed at a table to eat, provides zero protection, unless the environment had zero air flow and an air lock at every entrance.

10. As governor, Inslee is not given the power to issue law. His orders are guidelines, not law. The legislature makes law.

11. The Oaths of Office for every officer of the law and elected official in Washington state, whether Mayor, or City Councillor, is to uphold the laws of the land AND the Constitutions of the Nation and of Washington State. The Constitutions are considered the Supreme Law of the land, and when Law contradicts the Constitution, this is clearly a point where the Law is unjust, unenforceable, and must be stricken from the books.

12. Our Natural Rights can not be violated by anyone, in government or otherwise.

13. Initial focus of Emergency Orders by Inslee was to "flatten the curve", in order to keep hospitals from becoming overwhelmed. This never happened in WA State, and in fact hospitals were so slow for months that there were layoffs across the state. The National Guard Hospital set up at CenturyLink Field never had a single patient. Then Inslee changed his focus to "Stay Home, Save Lives" and no one challenged him.

14. ReOpen Washington rallies were held across the state every weekend from April 19th, with thousands in attendance. Very few wore masks or kept their distance; hugs and handshakes were common, and yet there was no spike at the 2 week incubation points after these "exposures" which should have unleashed a firestorm of infections (per media and government claim). This further documents how much the media has blown the fear out of proportion.

15. There is a cost in human suffering from quarantine and shelter-in-place measures. This cost is in suicide, depression, anxiety, lost income, inability to feed family, bankrupt businesses, and could lead to the destruction of downtown Camas. Mask orders, social distancing, contact tracing will also have their negative impact.

16. Waiting for a vaccine to return life to normal is not a plan. There is no approved vaccine, they are still in trial. Of the two highly publicized and "hoped" for vaccines: Moderna's in Seattle, and Oxford's attempt have revealed significant concerns. So far it has been reported that 20% of high-dose group in Seattle had serious injuries that required medical intervention. For Oxford, the animal trial proved that the vaccine did not protect from the wild coronavirus. In either case, or for any other vaccine, they are being rushed through, cutting corners and we will have to wait years to see what the downstream health effects of these are. In 2004, work on a SARS vaccine was tested in animal trial and specifically warned against human trial, due to a deadly cytokine storm that developed after exposing the animals to wild coronavirus. It has been noted repeatedly by scientists that SARS and COVID-19 are very similar.

Vaccine Risky, Will Not Be Soon

In closing, We The People request the City of Camas to show that they represent our best interests and to act independently, not at the will of the State of Washington. We ask you to remember your Oaths of Office and that we elected you to represent us, not to run dictates down from the State.

We require the above petition and acknowledgements to be voted on by the city within 30 days. Else it is assumed that the city does not acknowledge any of the points above, including that they agree that our Natural Rights can be violated.
